All operating and assembly procedures should be performed by an adult:

- · The child should be secured in the high chair at all times by the restraining system, either in the reclining or upright position. The tray is not designed to hold the child in the chair. It is recommended that the high chair be used in the upright position only by children capable of sitting upright unassisted.
- · Prevent serious injury or death from falls or sliding out. Always secure child in restraint system.
- · Do not use this high chair for more than one child at a time and do not leave other children playing unattended near the high chair.
- · To avoid the risk of fire, never leave the high chair near sources of strong heat such as open fires, electric heaters, and gas stoves. If the highchair is exposed to direct sunlight, wait for it to cool down before placing your child in it.


- · Adjust the 5-point harness according to the size of your child. Adjust for every recline position.
- Do not leave the high chair near walls, curtains, or windows, where the child can become tangled, or where a child may be able to use its feet to push against the high chair.
- · Never place the high chair near stairs or steps.
- Do not adjust the height or recline of product with the child in it.
- · Do not move the product with the child in it.
- · ALWAYS use seat belt.
- · Never leave child unattended. Always keep your child in view.
- · Do not place any heavy bags, packages, or other items on the high chair tray. They may cause the high chair to tip over.
- Do not use accessories, spare parts, and components other than those supplied by Combi®.

- · STRANGULATION HAZARD: Do not place product in any location where there are cords, such as window blind cords, phone cords,
- Do not force tray against child. Use only the three adjustment positions. Always ensure both sides of tray are locked in place.

This product is designed as a high chair for use with child up to 3 years of age. Total maximum weight of child MUST not exceed 40lbs (18kg).

This product meets or exceeds all requirements covered in the ASTM F404 Standard Consumer Safety Specification for High Chairs.

HIGH CHAIR ASSEMBLY

ATTACHING THE SEAT CUSHION AND HARNESS




1. Place the seat cushion on the seating area of your high chair. Route the shoulder straps through the slots in the backrest.



2. Gently pull the top portion of the seat cushion over the backrest.



3. Fit the recline lever through the slot at the top of the seat cushion.



4. Route the waist belt portion of the harness into the slots at the rear of the high chair. Repeat on the opposite side of seat.



5. Route the crotch belt portion of the harness into the slot behind the middle post.



6. Pull bottom portion of seat cushion over middle post.



7. Attach snaps to both side of the seat cushion as shown.



8. Attach the Velcro to the post of the footrest.

HIGH CHAIR ASSEMBLY

REMOVING THE SEAT CUSHION AND HARNESS

Follow the previous directions of "Attaching the Seat Cushion and Harness" in reverse.

ATTACHING/REMOVING THE TRAY



Attaching The Tray: Squeeze the adjuster lever located under the tray while placing the tray onto the main body of the high chair. Pull the tray to ensure that it is secure before use.



Removing The Tray: Squeeze the adjuster lever for the tray while pulling the tray away from the high chair.

ADJUSTING THE TRAY



- 1. Squeeze the adjuster lever located under the tray and position the tray to the desired use position.
- 2. Pull the tray to ensure that it is secure before use.

WARNING: Do not force tray against child. Use only the three adjustment positions. Always ensure both sides of tray are locked in place.

ATTACHING/REMOVING THE SNACK TRAY



Attaching The Snack Tray


Place the snack tray over the tray and snap into place on both sides.

Removing The Snack Tray

Pull up on both sides to release the snack tray from the main tray.

HIGH CHAIR OPERATION

UNFOLDING AND FOLDING THE HIGH CHAIR




1. To unfold the high chair, hold the backrest while pushing down on the rear leg assembly until the rear leg assembly locks into position



2. To fold the high chair, pull up on the folding mechanism on each side of the high chair while leaning the high chair back, then pull up on the rear leg assembly until the rear leg is upright.

ADJUSTING THE HEIGHT



1. Squeeze the height adjustment buttons on both sides of your high chair while pulling up or lowering down to adjust the high chair to your desired position. There are 5 height use positions.



STORAGE POSITION

WARNING: The lowest position is not a use position. This position is for storage purposes only.


WARNING: Do not adjust the height of product with the child in it.

HIGH CHAIR OPERATION

USING THE HARNESS

Buckling the Harness

- 1. Place the crotch belt between the baby's legs.
- 2. Insert buckle tongues into each side of buckle.
- 3. Lift buckle with tongues inserted and attach right and left harness hooks to holes in buckle tongues.
- 4. To adjust the harness or waist belt, loosen the slack on both sides of each buckle and adjust to desired position.



- 1. Press levers down on right and left harness hooks to detach shoulder straps from buckle tongues.
- 2. Press center buckle button down while gently pulling buckle tongues from buckle to release.





WARNING: Avoid serious injury from falling or sliding out. Always use the 5-point harness.


ADJUSTING THE RECLINING BACKREST



1. Pull up on the recline lever and adjust the backrest to the desired position. There are 3 recline positions.

WARNING: Do not adjust recline of product with the child in it.

MOVING THE HIGH CHAIR



1. Lift up the front legs off the floor. You can then move the high chair freely on the rear wheels.

WARNING: Do not move the high chair with the child

HIGH CHAIR OPERATION

PREPARING THE HIGH CHAIR FOR STORAGE









- 1. Adjust the height of the high chair to the storage position.
- 2. Fold the rear legs as shown.
- 3. Remove the tray from the main body.
- 4. Notice the location shown on the tray and rear leg to retain the tray for storage.
- 5. Place the tray on the rear leg.



ROUTINE MAINTENANCE

Store in a cool and dry area, especially in the summer. To avoid damaging stroller, NEVER place items on top of the high chair during storage.

Seat Cushion and Restraint System:

Wipe soiled area with a warm, damp cloth.

High Chair Frame

To clean the frame, wipe with a warm, damp cloth then wipe out any traces of moisture on the frame with a dry cloth.

For service, call 1-800-99-Combi (1-800-992-6624). For warranty service, please contact your Combi retailer. The warrantor shall not be responsible for any costs incurred by the consumer in returning a defective product for repair. The consumer will be responsible for all shipping and handling for replacement parts.
