





1 Lay top shelf (with handle and tray), ribbed side up on a smooth surface. Push all 4 legs onto leg posts.




Position bottom shelf, ribbed side up, over the 4 legs and insert leg posts into legs. Using a rubber mallet, firmly hammer bottom shelf into legs until all four legs are seated (flush) against the surfaces of both shelves.




3 Push the four casters firmly into the holes in each corner of the bottom shelf. Important: casters must be fully seated. Tap firmly with rubber mallet to properly seat casters. Turn your Endura Table right side up.


Slide 6 dividers into any of the twelve slots provided. It is now ready for use.






1 Lay top shelf (with handle and tray), ribbed side up on a smooth surface. Push all 4 legs onto leg posts.




2 Position center shelf (with 8 leg posts), ribbed side up, over the 4 legs and insert leg posts into legs. Using a rubber mallet, firmly hammer center shelf into legs until all four legs are seated (flush) against the surfaces of both shelves.




3 Push other set of 4 legs into leg posts of second shelf and firmly hammer until properly seated.



Position bottom shelf, ribbed side up, over the 4 legs and insert leg posts into legs. Using a rubber mallet, firmly hammer bottom shelf into legs until all four legs are seated (flush) against the surfaces of both shelves.



5 Push the four casters firmly into the holes in each corner of the bottom shelf. Important: casters must be fully seated. Tap firmly with rubber mallet to properly seat casters. Turn your Endura Table right side up.

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
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
Handle O Don't Use This Hole! Hinges

Step 1Align handle holes to the two predrilled holes on the lid and attach with two screws.


Lid/Lock Assembly
