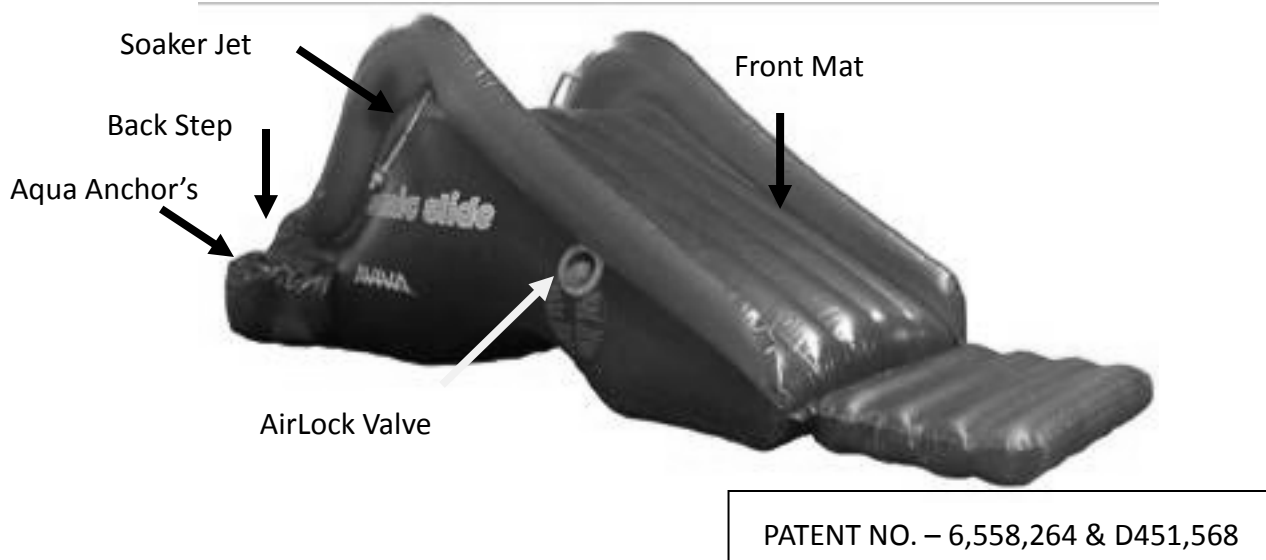

WARNING

INFLATION

The Cosmic Slide is inflated using any of the recommended types of inflators. Foot / Hand pumps are not recommended for the main chamber due to the size of the unit.

PARTS – The Cosmic Slide includes:

- 1 - AirLock Valve
- 3 - Stem Valves
- 2 - Water Anchors with valves
- 1 - Soaker Jet
- 1 - Soaker Jet connector (optional - for use only with a Quick Connect)
- 1 - Repair Kit consisting of: 2- 3" square clear self adhesive patches

POSITION

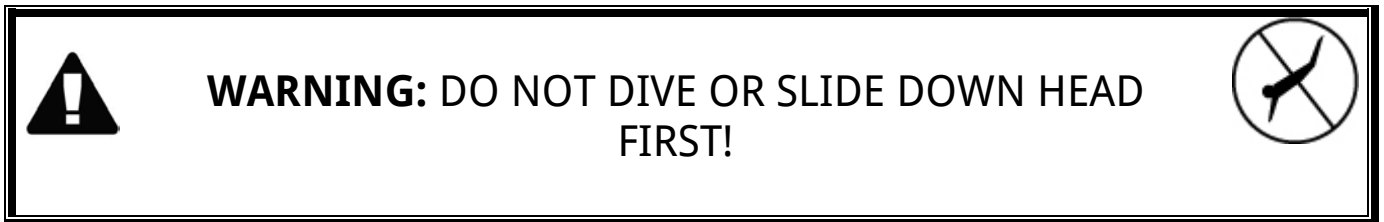
Place your Cosmic Slide with the front pad facing the water. The pad at the end of the slide should hang down and cover the edge of the pool and rest on the water's surface. There should be a minimum of 6 feet clearance all around the unit.

RECOMMENDED AGES – 4 +

RECOMMENDED MAXIMUM WEIGHT – 170 Lbs.

RECOMMENDED WATER DEPTH – 5 Feet

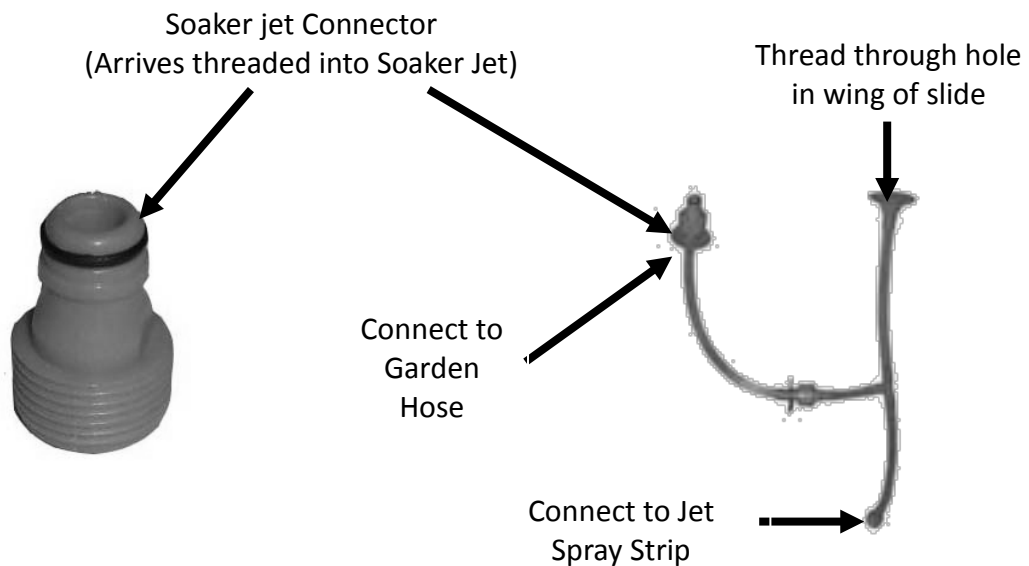
All inflatables are sensitive to cold, therefore never unfold or inflate in temperatures below 50° F.

Watch for the attachment ring around the AirLock valve and cap! Be careful if you remove the attachment ring that attaches the valve to the product, as it can get caught between the threads and the valve. This will damage the seal and cause air to leak from the unit. This damage voids the warranty.

We recommend a 120 volt high volume inflator. Most of these units come with a variety of nozzles that will fit the valves we use on our products. Always take care not to over inflate the product.

HOSE CONNECTION

If you do not have a quick connect on your hose, simply unscrew the Soaker Jet connector to connect to your garden hose. Otherwise, connect the quick connect to the Soaker Jet connector and turn water on. Adjust the flow of water by turning your water faucet dial to desired flow.



AQUA ANCHORS

AVIVA has attached Aqua Anchors to its Water Slides to provide stability.

Aqua Anchor Valves – Open valve with the tab on the plug. Place your garden hose on top of hole and fill with water until almost firm. Replace the plug by pressing hard on the middle of the plug with your thumb over the opening.

Failure to fill each Aqua Anchor fully may result in movement or tipping of your unit.

DEFLATION

PRIOR TO DEFLATION, REMOVE ALL CHILDREN FROM THE UNIT!

Use one of the Inflator/Deflator devices recommended in the “Inflation” Section for faster deflation.

AirLock Valve - Unscrew the large AirLock valve to quickly deflate the main chamber. Then place the deflation portion of the inflation/deflation device on top of the valve and remove all air. You will know you have all the air out when the unit is flat and wrinkled. Replace valve.

Stem Valves - Insert the deflation portion of the inflation/deflation device with the appropriate attachment connector. You may also gently squeeze the base of the valve to release air. You will know you have all the air out when the unit is flat and wrinkled. Replace plug.

Water Valves – **Remove water from the Aqua Anchors (Slides only).** Remove the cap and squeeze all the water out. A very small amount of water remaining in the chamber will not harm the unit. Keep in mind though that water left inside for a period of time may start to mold.

Completely Dry Unit. **Wipe the product off with a terry cloth towel and allow to dry completely.** Store for next use. See Storage Section for details.
