






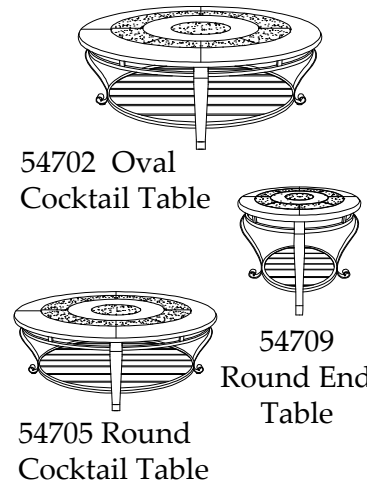
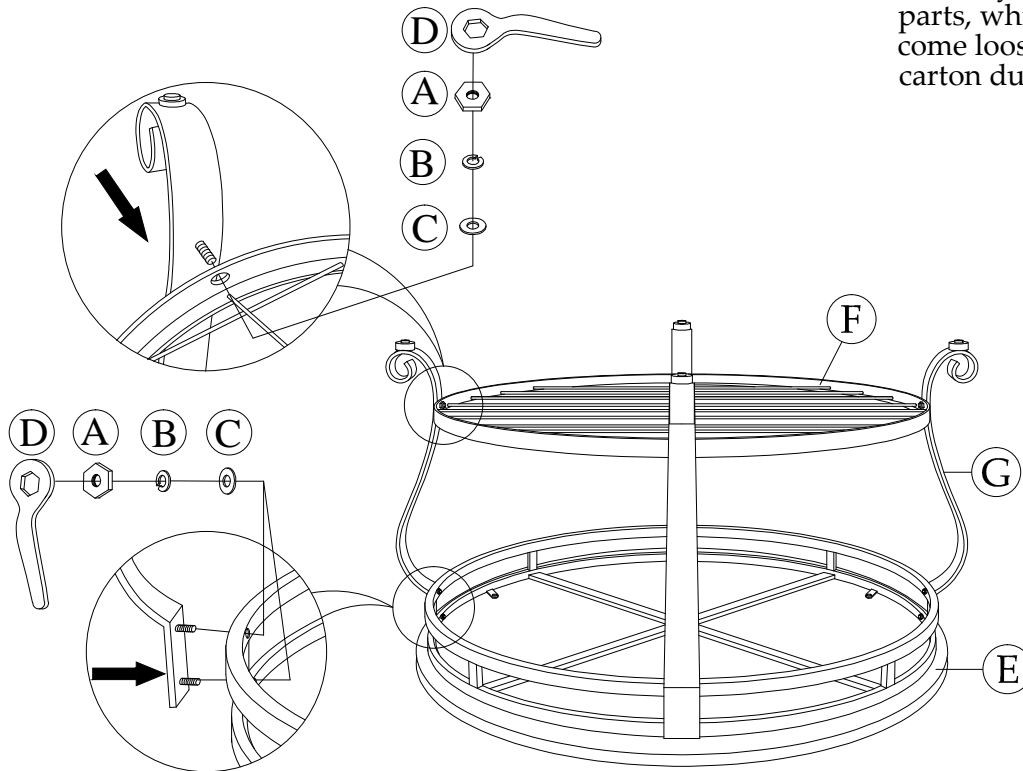


Components and Hardware List

<p>M1/4" Nut</p>  <p>(A) 12 pcs.</p>	<p>1/4" Spring Washer</p>  <p>(B) 12 pcs.</p>	<p>1/4" x 16mm Flat Washer</p>  <p>(C) 12 pcs.</p>	<p>Wrench</p>  <p>(D) 1 pc.</p>

Be sure to check all packing material carefully for small parts, which may have come loose inside the carton during shipment.



Note:

1. Do not discard any packing materials until the table has been completely assembled, to prevent parts from being accidentally discarded. To prevent possible scratches or damages, assemble the table upside down on a soft surface such as a blanket or carpet, or its own packaging materials.
2. Remove the drawer, attach three Legs (G) to the Top (E) using Flat Washers (C), Spring Washers (B) and Nuts (A). Do not fully tighten Nuts until after step 4.
3. Attach the Bottom Shelf (F) to the Legs using the same washers and nuts as before. Do not fully tighten Nuts until after next step.
4. Attach the remaining Leg as in the previous steps.
5. Tighten all the Nuts using the Wrench (D).
6. Carefully turn the Table upright.
7. Levelers are installed into the bottom of the Legs and can be used to compensate for uneven flooring if necessary.
