SPACER TO ELEVATE BOBRICK LAVATORY-MOUNTED SOAP DISPENSERS

When holes for lavatory-mounted soap dispensers are properly situated, the spout of soap dispenser will project over the lavatory bowl so there is sufficient space for hands and no soap can collect on the rim of bowl of the countertop.

Bobrick's B-822, B-8221 group of dispensers are so designed that the standard unit will span most self-rimming bowls with adequate clearance to operate the piston. There are a few higher-than-average self-rimming bowls now on the market, and to clear those may require a spacer. Bobrick can supply Part No. 822-111, which will elevate the dispenser 1" (25mm).

The same 822-111 spacer can be used if the installer has drilled the hole too far away from the bowl, making it difficult to place hands between the spout of soap dispenser and the rim of bowl or the countertop.

Replacement piston-and-spout assemblies with a 6" (152mm) spout projection are also available to help correct improperly placed lavatory-mounted dispensers. Ask for Part No. 8226-23.
