

CARE AND CLEANING

Use coasters to prevent the formation of moisture rings and trivets to protect from hot items. Cover extension leaves (if applicable) with a soft protective fabric before storing. Do not slide objects across the surface - always lift them.

Check bolts/screws periodically and tighten them if necessary.



STEP 1

The table legs (B) have been packaged with pre-installed bolts. Remove the plastic plugs covering the bolts on table legs (B).

Place table top (A) upside down on a clean smooth surface.


Attach table legs (B) to table top (A) with nuts (1), spring washers (3) and flat washers (2) as shown. Tighten nuts (1) using wrench (4).



STEP 2

Attach seat frame (G) to back frame (C) with short bolts (6), long bolts (5), spring washers (3) and flat washers (2) as shown. Do not fully tighten the bolts in this step.


Note: Seat frame (G) has holes on each side. These holes are to attached the seat board (F) in the in the next step. Ensure that the wider end of the holes face down towards the ground.



STEP 3

Place seat board (F) upside down on a clean smooth surface.

Attach the assembled chair frame to seat board (F) with wood screws (7) using a Phillips head screw driver (not included).



STEP 4

Attach chair left and right front legs (E&D) to chair seat frame (G) with flat washers (2), spring washers (3), and nuts (1). Do not fully tighten nuts (1).


Insert the chair front crossbar (J) to the front chair legs (E & D) as shown.

Insert side crossbars (H & I) to the front left and right chair legs (E&D) and chair back frame (C).


NOTE: The small holes on all crossbars must face towards the ground (when the chair is in the normal use position).

Tighten all nuts previously installed with wrench (4).

Secure the front crossbar (J) and side crossbars (I&H) to chair legs with wood screws (7) as shown below. Repeat Steps 2-4 to assemble the remaining chairs.
