

LEATHER CARE

CLEAN: Dust the entire surface of your furniture weekly with a clean, dry cloth. If necessary wipe with a white cloth dampened with clean water. Avoid using cleaning products or solutions as these may stain or discolor the surface.

SPILL: Act quickly with spills. Absorb the spill with a clean white cloth or paper towel. Never rub the surface. If the spill has already set, use a mild, dye-free detergent mixed with lukewarm water and blot with a clean cloth or sponge. For a difficult stain use a gentle leather spot removal product. Before using, test on an inconspicuous area. For large stains or difficult spots, call a professional upholstery cleaner.

AVOID: Keep your leather and leather alternative furniture away from direct heat and sunlight. Heat and sunlight can dry out the surface of your furniture and cause cracking and fading. Also never leave heavy or sharp objects on or against your furniture as this could puncture the surface or cause permanent indentations.

POLISHED STAINLESS STEEL

SHINE: Use a clean, soft, cotton cloth to shine the stainless steel.
