

Faucet Installation Instructions

CL101

- \bullet Hole Diameters are 1 $\% {\rm ^{"}}$ minimum to 1 $5 {\rm ^{"}}$ maximum
- Maximum deck thickness is 1 ½"
- This faucet comes completely assembled and water tested
- Tools required-channel lock pliers (or pipe wrench), basin wrench, small crescent wrench and Teflon tape
- Shut off water supply prior to beginning installation



Step 2 Make sure copper tubes (2A) are installed facing away from the spout. Align handles to desired position and then secure valves from underneath with metal washers and threaded Hot valve is marked with red tag and should be installed on the left side of the spout. locknuts. Hand tighten locknuts onto shank insert valves through mounting hole in sink





Connect the supply hoses (3A) to the bottom of valve bodies (3B) as shown. Step 3




Carefully end hoses (3A) to fit available space and thread hose couplings onto sides of the Tee (3B). Insert Tee (3B) onto spout shank until it is completely seated. Place clip (3C) onto slot at bottom of Tee to secure.



Make connections to 1/2" IPS water lines (4A, not included). Use wrenches to tighten connections. Do not overtighten. Step 5



Remove stopper (1) and flange (2). Screw nut (3) all the way down. Push washer (4) and gasket (5) down. Remove tailpiece (6) from body (7), add Teffon tape, replace tailpiece. Step 6



Attach horizontal rod (1) to strap (2) using clip (3). Insert lift rod (4) into strap and tighten screw (5).

Important: After installation is completed, remove aerator. Turn on water supply and allow both hot and cold water for run for at least one minute each. While water is running check for leaks. Replace aerator. Step 10





Step 8 Remove pivot nut (1). Insert stopper (3) into drain body then insert rod (2) into eyelet of stopper (as shown above). Hand tighten pivot nut (1).

Apply a small bead of Plumber's putty to underside of flange (1). Insert body (2) into sink. Screw flange (1) into body (2). Pivot (3) must face back wall. Pull assembly down firmly and hold in place DO NOT TWIST. Tighten nut, washer & gasket (4), clean off excess Plumber's
