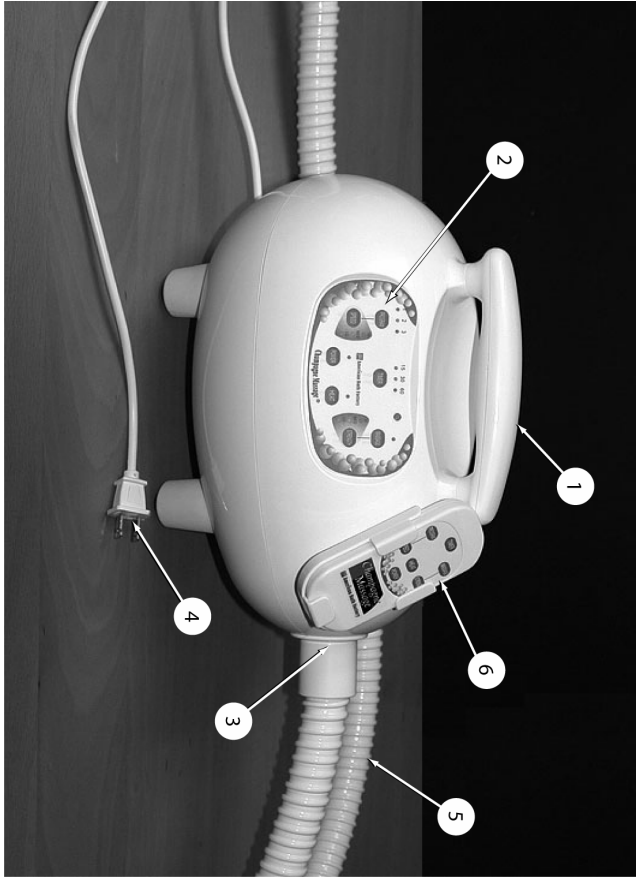
CHECK YOUR BATHTUB THOROUGHLY FOR DAMAGE

prior to installation in your home

It is possible that during shipping, damage has occurred.

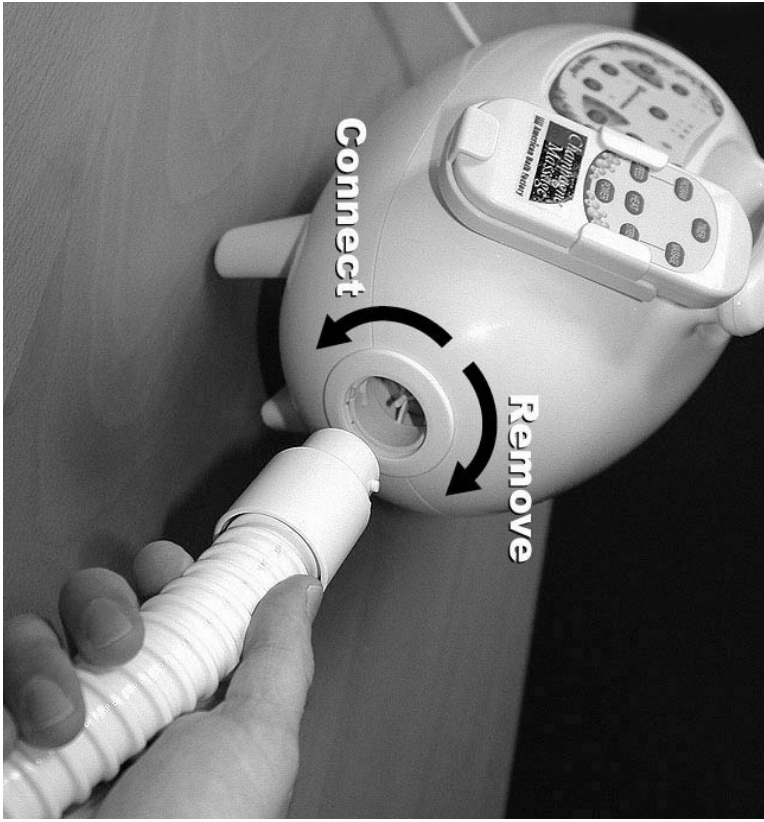
Shipment verification:

- Check packing list with complete list of items you have received to ensure you are not missing any products ordered.
- Open the 17" X 11" white box that contains the Champagne Massage® Blower unit and Remote Control. (1, 6)



Name of parts:

1. Champagne Blower Unit
2. Control Panel (On Unit)
3. Air Exit Location (Air Intake under unit)
4. Power Plug and cord (Attached to Unit)
5. Blower Hose (Attached to bathtub)
6. Remote Control



Connect the hose, which is attached to the bathtub on to the blower unit by inserting male hose end to female opening on blower, then twisting the hose counter clockwise to lock and secure.

Water Testing your Bathtub

Plug the drain and with a garden hose fill your bathtub just below the overflow. **Caution** Keep water away from the blower unit. Use only a GFI (Ground Fault Interrupter) protected on tlet to safeguard against electrical shock. Next, plug the cord from blower into nearest outlet (if an extension cord is required make sure union is in location where water cannot come in contact with electricity). Inspect for leaks. Turn on the Champagne Massage System (page 3) using either the remote control or the control panel on the blower. Test the different settings, and ensure the system is working properly. Inspect again for leaks.

Attaching your Champagne Massage® Components

Connect the hose, which is attached to the bathtub on to the blower unit by inserting male hose end to female opening on blower, then twisting the hose counter clockwise to lock and secure.

Operating the Remote Control

Point the remote control at the infrared receiver head on the control panel on the main body and then press the corresponding button. The buttons on the Remote Control correspond to the buttons on the Control Panel on the Blower Unit.

Remote control working distance ≤ 20 feet
Remote control angle $\leq 30^\circ$



Operating the Control Panel

Choose the function type you need. Press the Massage or Program button:

PROGRAM – Choose between the three programs.

SPEED – Controls the air bubbles flow speed. There are three choices: High, Medium, and Low.

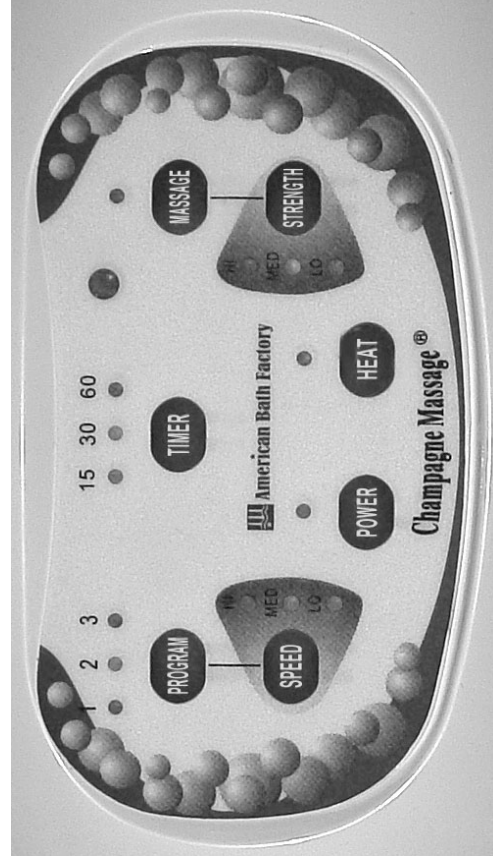
TIMER – The treatment time you require. There are three choices: 15 min, 30 min, and 60 min

HEAT – Controls the heating device. Pressing it will produce warm bubbles.

POWER - Turns On/Off the Blower.

MESSAGE – Shows the normal massage type.

STRENGTH -Shows the strength of bubble action. There are three choices: Low, Medium, and High.

Warnings

1. Do not dip the blower into water.
2. Do not disassemble and reassemble the blower.
3. Do not remove the supply plugs with wet hands.
4. Do not remove the plug by pulling the cable.
5. If the blower fails to function normally, for safety reasons, switch off the power and call the manufacturer.
6. Do not clean the blower in water.
7. Parts incorporating electrical components, except the remote control, must be located or fixed so that they cannot fall into the bathtub.
8. Do not put the blower on a wet surface when using it. Keep the surface dry during use.
9. Danger: Do not try to replace/repair the blower unit yourself.
10. Do not dip or drop the remote into water, as it is water-resistant, not water-proof.
11. Make sure bathtub feet are secured to the ground. (This will ensure plumbing is not damaged from movement of the bathtub).
12. Before plugging in Champagne Massage Blower Unit to be sure to **Use only a GFI (Ground Fault Interrupter) protected outlet to safeguard against electrical shock.**

Troubleshooting

Here are some suggested solutions for some common issues that might affect your bathtub or affect the operation of your Champagne Massage® Blower. Please call American Bath Factory at (800) 454-2284 about any issues you cannot resolve or questions you may have about your bathtub. Your satisfaction is our primary goal.

Bathtub is Leaking

1. Verify that the drain is installed securely and that the rubber gasket is seated properly between the bottom of the bathtub and the drain pipe.
2. Verify that the drain is installed with SILICONE and not plumber's putty. See instructions on page 5. Re-apply SILICONE as necessary to ensure a watertight seal. Verify that the overflow cover is tightened securely into the overflow drain and that the rubber overflow gasket is seated properly between the bathtub and overflow drain.
3. Ensure that all faucet hardware is installed properly and securely. Replace worn washers and gaskets as necessary.
4. Check all water supply lines for leaks. Replace washers or gaskets as necessary.

After testing your bathtub you are ready for installation assuming no problems were found.

Recommendations

1. When filling your Champagne Massage® bathtub do not overflow with water and remember that when you get into your bathtub, the water level will rise.
2. After your bath we recommend that while the bathtub is draining to turn on your blower with the heat setting on for 3-5 minutes to blow out any water and to dry out the lines.

Blower fails to operate

1. Ensure the power cord is properly plugged into a GFI protected outlet.
2. Check ground fault circuit interrupter. Reset if tripped.
3. Check electronic power supply. Reset circuit breaker or replace fuse if necessary.
4. If the system has been running properly for an extended period it is possible that the thermal protection system has shut off the motor. Unplug the system for at least 30 minutes. Try the system again after 30 minutes.
5. Check and replace the batteries in your Remote Control if necessary

Blower is blowing cold air

1. At the beginning of your bath, the blower has not had time to warm up and the air coming from the massage jets may feel cool. The air will warm shortly after you start the blower as the blower motor warms up.
2. People with sensitive skin might experience a "cold air effect" which is caused by the sensation of air bubbles running along the wet skin and may cause a shivering sensation. People with extra sensitive skin may experience this effect even if the air blown through the jets is very warm.

Monthly maintenance

Fill your bathtub with approximately 1/2" of water. Add 1 cup of household bleach and let mixture stand for 15 minutes before draining. Refill the bathtub with water to normal operating level and run the blower for five minutes. Drain your bathtub with the blower on for 3-5 minutes after bathtub is completely drained to dry the lines.

Day to day operation

Prior to turning on the Champagne Massage Blower Unit fill bathtub with water to desired level.

When in bathtub only turn on/off or adjust settings with the remote control not with the control panel on the blower unit.

After your bath we recommend that while the bathtub is draining to turn on your blower with the heat setting on for 3-5 minutes to blow out any water and to dry out the lines.
