

GENERAL PRODUCT INFORMATION:




This product can mount to either a 4" square electrical box with round plaster ring or an octagon electrical box.

This product is suitable for wet locations.

This product can be dimmed with a standard incandescent dimmer.


This instruction shows a typical installation.




This product requires installation by a qualified electrician. Before installing be sure to read all instructions and TURN THE POWER TO THE **ELECTRICAL BOX OFF.**




Install the Fixture




With the Allen wrench provided, back out (Do Not **Remove)** the set screw at the base of the sconce.




Pull out the mounting plate from the fixture base.




- Make sure the two tabs on the mounting plate are positioned at the top and bottom of the plate.
- 4 Line up two mounting plate slots with the two electrical box holes
- Level the mounting plate and secure it to the electrical box with the two #8-32 screws provided.



- Ground the mounting plate in accordance with local electrical codes.
- Connect the white fixture wire to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut.
- 8 Connect the black fixture wire to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.




- Place all wires and wire nut connections properly inside the electrical box.
- 10 Hook the top of the fixture base over the mounting plate top tab.




- Line up the fixture on the wall and then secure it to the mounting plate by tightening the set screw at the base of the fixture.
- **For wet location installation**, caulk around the fixture base with waterproof construction sealant.

Install the Lamp



CAUTION: To reduce the risk of a burn or electric shock during relamping, disconnect the power to the fixture.


1 Unscrew and remove the shade guard along with the glass shade. **Do not remove the gasket from the glass shade.**



Use **MAX** 120 Volt, **100** Watt Type A19 Medium Base Lamp.



2 Screw the lamp into the socket.



Carefully replace and tighten the shade guard along with the glass shade into the socket housing.

NOTE: Do not overtighten the shade guard which may cause the glass shade to break.
