

Assembly Instruction Sheet #IS-TF961FVB For Style TF961FVB

Tools Required: Flathead screwdriver, Phillips screwdriver, pliers, wire cutters, wire strippers, electrical tape, safety glasses. **Bulb Recommended:** (2) Medium Base 75W Maximum, Alternate bulb (2) 19W CFL

Estimated Assembly Time: 20-30 minutes

Preparation: Identify and inspect all parts before beginning installation. Check package content list and diagrams below to be sure all parts are present. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble, install, or operate the fixture. Contact customer service for replacement parts.

Δ Warnings and Cautions

Turn off electricity at circuit breaker or main fuse box before installation. Consult a licensed electrician if in doubt.

These instructions are provided for your safety. It is very important you read them completely before installing the fixture. We strongly recommend that a licensed, professional electrician perform the installation.

Disconnect fixture from power source before replacing bulbs. Make sure bulbs are given sufficient time to cool before removal. Do not subject glass parts to any shock while in operation or shattering may result.

▲ Care of Tiffany Style Shade

A new tiffany lamp shade has an oil film applied to the shade that protects the tiffany shade from scratches during shipment. If the oil applied is too heavy you can remove the excess oil film with a paper towel. Gently wipe away the excess oil.

For general cleaning of tiffany shades use a gentle lemon oil-based furniture polish applied to a soft cloth and wipe gently.

If a white powder appears on the soldered joints of the tiffany shade this is a normal oxidation process. Use a small amount of lemon oil or mineral oil applied directly to oxidized areas and the soldered area will return to like new.

Finial STEP 1 - Install Nipple with HEX TF961FVB Π 'Sq. X 1 Nut, Shade and Bulb FINISH: VINTAGE BRONZE Shade A. Thread the Socket Assembly, X 1 the Rod, the Threaded Rods 95 and the Base together as shown. Hand tighten until snug. (2)B. Pull the cord from the Base as you assemble the parts together to remove the excess cord Flat **Bia Knurled** between parts. Washer Nut x 1 C. Thread have hex nut end of x 1 Nipple with Hex Nut into Hex Check Ring Coupling on the top of Socket Small Knurled Assembly. 1 x Nut Spacer D. Place Spacer and Check Ring x 1 over the Nipple. Secure by thread Small Knurled Nut onto Nipple with 62' the Nipple, hand tighten until Hex Nut x 1 snua. E. Thread Big Knurled Nut onto à 🖨 Nipple. Hand tighten until snug. Socket F. Place the Flat Washer and the Assembly Shade over the Nipple. Adjust Bulb (not x 1 the Big Knurled Nut to proper included) location for the Flat Washer, the Shade and Finial. secure by thread Finial onto the Nipple, hand tighten until snug. G. This fixture uses standard bulb Threaded with medium base. Maximum 75 Rod watts. Insert bulb and screw (1)x 1 snugly into place. Your fixture is now assembled Rod and ready to use.
