

## opening/folding the walker

 Grasp the top hand grip of the walker.
 With other hand, push the pivot lock handle down towards the cross brace.

NOTE: The pivot lock MUST be directly on top of the cross brace.

Reverse STEP 1 to close the walker.



## adjusting the leg extensions

 Adjust leg extensions by depressing the snap button through the appropriate extension and allowing it to snap through the appropriate hole on the walker leg frame.

NOTE: Make certain the snap buttons are fully engaged into the adjustment hole of each leg frame and are at the same height before using.

2. Repeat this procedure for each of the leg extensions.


