## ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

## **BG-PDD070**

WARNING: BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER AT THE MAIN FUSE OR CIRCUIT BREAKER BOX BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.

NOTE: 1. Before installing, consult local electrical codes for wiring and grounding requirements. 2. READ AND SAVE THIS INSTRUCTION.


- 1. Thread two screws to the mounting strap, then secure them with two lock nuts. Adjust the length of the screws if necessary.
- 2. Attach the mounting strap to the outlet box by using two mounting screws.
- 3. Rod connections:
  - a. Thread the fixture wire from the fixture through the lower rod and secure the lower rod with the nipple.
  - b. Thread the fixture wire from the lower rod through the middle rod and secure the middle rod with the nipple.
  - c. Thread the fixture wire through the upper rod, then secure the upper rod with the nipple.

The height can be adjusted to 25-1/2", 35" or 44-1/2" by using the rods.

- 4. Thread the fixture wire through the canopy, then secure the upper rod to the canopy with the set nipple.
- 5. Pull out the outlet wires and the house grounding wire from the outlet box. Make wire connections using the wire nuts:
  - --- The smooth wire (marked) from the fixture to the black wire from the power source.
  - ---The ridged wire (unmarked) from the fixture to the white wire from the power source.
  - --- Attach the fixture grounding wire to the mounting strap with the green grounding screw. Then connect it to the house grounding wire with a wire nut.

Carefully tuck the wires back into the outlet box.

- 6. Attach the canopy to the mounting strap by inserting the screws, then secure it with two bolt nuts.
- 7. Attach the glass shade and counter ring to the glass holder, then secure them with the socket ring.
- 8. Install a bulb (not included). See relamping label at socket area or packaging for maximum allowed wattage.
- 9. Turn on the power at the main fuse or circuit breaker box.
