ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER AT THE MAIN FUSE OR CIRCUIT BREAKER BOX BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.

NOTE: 1.Before installing, consult local electrical codes for wiring and grounding requirements. 2.READ AND SAVE THIS INSTRUCTION.

- 1.Attach the nipple(-a) to the mounting strap, then secure it with a washer and a hex nut.
- 2.Attach the mounting strap to the outlet box by using two mounting screws.
- 3.Secure the finial(-b) to the nipple(-b) tightly.
- 4.Choose the length of the chains you need, then weave the fixture wire and the fixture grounding wire through one of the chains, top loop and canopy.
- 5.Connect one ends of the chains with the loops by using two loop locks.
- 6.Connect the other ends of the chains with the top loops by using another two loop locks.
- 7.Pull out the outlet wires and house grounding wire from the outlet box. Make wire connections using the wire nuts:
 - ---The smooth wire (marked) from the fixture to the black wire from the power source.
 - ---The ridged wire (unmarked) from the fixture to the white wire from the power source.
 - ---Attach the fixture grounding wire to the mounting strap with the green grounding screw. Then connect it to the house grounding wire with a wire nut.

Carefully tuck the wires back into the outlet box.

- 8.Attach the canopy to the mounting strap by inserting the nipple(-a), then secure it with the finial(-a).
- 9.Screw the nipple(-c) to the coupling, secure it with a washer and a hex nut. Attach the cover to the fixture by inserting the nipple(-c) and secure it with the finial(-c).
- 10.Attach the glass shades to the glass holders, then secure them with the socket rings.
- 11.Install bulbs (not included). See relamping label at socket area or packaging for maximum allowed wattage.
- 12. Turn on the power at the main fuse or circuit breaker box.
