

Kaye “All-Terrain” Wheel Kits

Description and Use

Many children use their Kaye Posture Control or PostureRest Walkers to participate in outdoor activities in a large variety of setting, climates and terrains. Examples include; gravel playgrounds, grassy parks, campgrounds, sports fields, or on firm beaches and in light snow.

The Kaye “All Terrain” Wheel Kits, which are available for both Kaye Posture Control and PostureRest Walkers facilitate this outdoor use. The Kaye “All-Terrain” Wheel Kits are particularly useful when combined with Kaye PostureRest Walkers; the large wheels make the terrain more navigable and the seat allows the user a greater range in environments that may not have seating facilities available.

The large wheels require less energy when moving across rough, uneven terrain. The rear wheels include external ratchets to prevent rolling backward. The Kaye “All Terrain” Wheel Kits replaces the legs and wheels (or crutch tips) and are designed to retro fit sizes 1-5 Kaye Posture Control and PostureRest walkers. These wheels do not swivel.
