




## **Install the Fixture**








3 Lift the acrylic screen from the fixture base. Omit this step for Stingray Venus.




- Feed the power line wires through the crossbar assembly nipple.
- Ground the crossbar assembly in accordance with local electrical codes.
- Mount the crossbar assembly to the electrical box with provided two #8-32 screws.



- Feed the power line wires through the fixture base center hole, provided lock washer and nut.
- Slide the fixture base onto the crossbar assembly nipple, align the fixture base and tighten the nut to secure it against the wall.

- Connect the white ballast wire to the neutral power line wire with a wire nut
- Connect the black ballast wire to the hot power line wire with a wire nut.




**CAUTION:**To reduce the risk of a burn or electric shock during relamping, disconnect the power to the fixture.


For The Fixtures With Magnetic Ballast, Use **MAX 13** Watt Type Twin Tube GX23 Base Compact Fluorescent Lamp With Each Socket.

For The Fixtures With Electronic Ballast, Use **MAX 13** Watt Type Quad Tube G24q-1 Base Compact Fluorescent Lamp With Each Socket.

Install each lamp by pushing the lamp pins completely into the socket holes.



Replace the acrylic screen onto the fixture base. Make sure that the acrylic screen holes are properly set onto the fixture base posts. Hold the acrylic screen in place. Omit this step for Stingray Venus.



- Replace the metal screen/glass shade. Make sure that the metal screen/glass shade holes are properly set onto the fixture base posts.
- While holding the metal screen/glass shade in place, replace and tighten all four thumb screws.

**NOTE:** To replace the lamp, follow steps I though 3 on page I, remove the old lamp(s), and then follow steps I I though I4 on pages 2 and 3.
