

## 4 SEASON SOLARIUMS & GAZEBOS

- Where are these items made?
  - Made in China
- What is the roof made of?
  - Polycarbonate (rigid plastic), about 8mm thick, smoked colour with UV treatment on one side
- Are there windows?
  - There is screening on the outside and two window panels on the inside for each wall panel
- What are the windows made of?
  - PVC (flexible plastic)
- Can the windows be opened?
  - In each wall panel, there are two window panels that can slide up and down. A wall panel can be completely closed or two-thirds open for ventilation.
- What does “4 seasons” mean?
  - The unit will not have to be taken down in winter, unlike with vinyl-roofed gazebos which do have to be taken down.
- What kind of snow load can it take?
  - Some of these units have been installed in the Montreal area for over two years, and have survived significant snowstorms. We ask that you clear the snow off regularly, of course.
- What kind of winds can it take?
  - The unit is rated for Beaufort scale 9 or lower (winds of up to 88 km/h or 54 mph) if properly anchored
- Where can we put the doors?
  - For 41212, 41215, W1207, W1608, the doors can be put anywhere you have two panels side by side (not at an angle). For 41218, because it is a double door, it can only be put on one of the long sides.
- How is the solarium anchored?
  - Each wall panel has holes at the bottom to anchor into the ground with two long screws each. You need a solid base such as a wooden deck or concrete base. Plugs are provided if anchoring in concrete. The add-a-room models are also screwed into the wall along the back.
- What are the actual sizes of the units?
  - The 12x15 is actually 12x15'6. The 12x18 is actually 12x18'11". For the gazebos, the stated size is at the roof. All other units are very close to stated size, but we have footprints available by request.
- Do you make other sizes of solariums?
  - Not currently. The 4 Seasons models are imported and we are not equipped to make custom sizes.
- Where can I see the item?
  - We have a showroom with some of the models in it.
- How high is the item?
  - For the add-a-rooms (W1207 and W1608), it is 96" at the wall, 74" at the door. For the solariums, it is 110" at the peak, 79" at the doors. For the curtain gazebos, it is 110" at the peak, 78" clearance.
- Can the unit be heated?
  - Yes, although any heating unit must be kept safely away from the bottom plastic panels of the frames.
- Can we hang lights or fans in the unit?
  - Apart from the W1207 and W1608, our solariums and gazebos have U-rings to hang fixtures from. Electric cords can be run along a rafter to a wall frame and from there outside of the unit. Lights are fine, but caution is suggested with fans, as their movement might cause them to hit the sides of the roof.
