TO SHORTEN ROLL-UP BLINDS:

**Read instructions carefully
before cutting.**

**1. Glue EACH string 2-3 slats UP
from where you want to shorten
the blind. Make sure the glue is
dry BEFORE cutting.**

2. Cut BELOW the glued slats.

**3. Fold up the bottom two slats and
slide bottom rail on the blind.**
